	Four Barrow Hill = Bre Beder Krug	
	Galgeth = Kelgeth	
	Believed to contain <i>kel</i> 'hidden' + <i>keth</i> 'bond'.	
	Golden Lake = Frosan	
	Containing <i>fros</i> 'current, flow' + <i>-an</i> 'place of' suffix. The 1566 spelling "Gotton Lake" was linked to the Saxon verb <i>gēotan</i> —"to pour" or "to shed".	
	Gnatham = Trewibes	
	Recorded as Gnatham in 1506 and 1526.	
	Greymare Farm = Tregaseklos	
	This settlement is linked to Greymare Rock, with another nearby known as "her foal".	
	Grove = Tirkelli	
	Haygrove = Kroft Gora	
	Hendra = Hendra	
	Henwood Mill = DEFERRED	
	The Henwood family were landowners on the Cardinham tithe apportionment (1839). Their tenements included the "Cabilla Moorland" and "Milland" tenements. This mill may be the same Milland near Cabilla Manor (SX148693).	
	Higher Carblake = Karvleydh Wartha	
	Hill = Trevre	
	Higher Hill = Trevre Wartha	
	Lower Hill = Trevre Woles	
	Hole Farm = Tregew	
	Contains English 'hole' in reference to 'hollow'.	
	Hurtstocks Wood = Stokklos Stybb	
	Recorded as Horstokk 1496. Previously known as Horestocks Wood likely meaning 'grey stump' originally, before being

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reinterpreted as:

- Hurt-: Perhaps "hurt" or "hurtleberry" (whortleberry/bilberry), a type of wild berry common in Cornish woodlands.
- -stocks: Frequently refers to a tree stump, log, or a specific area of wood/timberland.

Kenketh = **Kenkidh**

Meaning an 'imparked residence'; compare Breton *kenkiz*.

Kingswood = **Koos an Myghtern**

Lahays = **An Hayow**

Recorded as Lahaygraue 1307. Referring to a number of enclosed fields.

Laneskin Wood = **Koos Nansheskyn**

Recorded as Lanhuskyn 1472. The element *hesken* 'sedge' seems likely here with marshland shown alongside the tributary.

Lang's Mill = **Melin Lang**

Leball Wood = **Koos Leghbal**

Recorded as Leghball c.1435–1455; account rolls of Cardinham manor. There was a quarry marked in Higher Leball field (plot number 1441) on the TA. Before corrupting further to "Le Ball".

Leball Farm = **Treleghbal**

Lemar = **Lannmargh**

The epoch 1 OS map (1875–1901) shows Lemar was ~500m southwest of its current location at SX093690. The current site of Lemar was recorded as "Meagor's Tenement".

Historical spellings for Lemar are similar to Lemarth (Mawgan-in-Men): Lanmargh, Lenmargh, Lanmarg c1280. Containing *lann* 'enclosure' + *margh* 'horse'.
